**Resolution Adopting the Wisconsin Rapids Safe Routes to School Plan 2026**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Grant, Portage County, supports improving walking and biking routes for students to get to school; and

**WHEREAS**, the health and safety of children is of highest concern to the citizens of the Town of Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, Safe Routes to School efforts help remove barriers to walking and biking to school, and reduce traffic congestion and speed in and around schools; and

**WHEREAS**, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) requires that to be eligible for funding of needed projects, municipalities and school districts must either create or amend their Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Plan to include needed projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Grant has developed a SRTS Plan for the dual purposes of serving as a guide for future programming and infrastructure improvements (the 5 E's of education, encouragement, engineering, enforcement, and evaluation); and to be eligible for various funding programs through WisDOT.

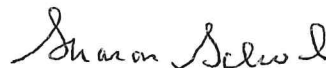
**WHEREAS**, the Town of Grant had staff on the SRTS Task Force; and

**WHEREAS**, the SRTS Task Force collected data, reviewed the results, and provided direction for SRTS Plan development, and then incorporated those results into the SRTS Plan; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town of Grant hereby adopts Resolution No. 2026-04

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Town of Grant's staff is directed to begin implementing this SRTS Plan by coordinating efforts among all entities who created this plan (City of Wisconsin Rapids, Town of Grant, Portage County, and Wisconsin Rapids Public Schools).

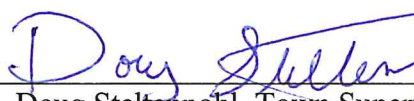
