Roadway Safety

Snow Plowing

- It's against state law to push snow across the roadway.
 - As ice/snow/slush freezes, it turns into a hazard.
- It is YOUR responsibility to clear the area around your mailbox.

Hazardous Roadways

- **ALWAYS** contact a board member with any concerns!
- Mud - We know it happens, but please have the respect to clean it up the best you can.
- Field Work - Traffic cones and warning signs can be provided if you know there may be a hazard near field driveways.
- Roadway Damage - Leaving ruts in the road with large equipment causes danger to our motorists. Be respectful and let us know if there is an issue that needs to be addressed. **LEGALLY**, the town can charge the responsible party up to 3x the cost of repairing the roadway.
- ATV/UTV motorists must follow all DNR rules with a speed limit of 35 MPH.
