

The Town Board of the Town of Jefferson, Jefferson County does amend the Town of Jefferson Driveway Ordinance as follows:

SECTION 1: Corrective Action

If a driveway is put in in violation of the Town of Jefferson's Driveway Ordinance then a certified letter shall be sent to the offending landowner giving the landowner ninety (90) days to correct the problem driveway. In the discretion of the Town Board and upon application from the landowner this ninety (90) day time period may be extended if there is good cause for not correcting the driveway problem within the above stated ninety (90) day period.

If no extension is granted or if the driveway is not corrected within the period stated above, the Town Board shall have the authority to order the driveway removed at the sole cost of the offending landowner or if necessary to petition the Court for injunctive relief permitting removal of the driveway. All costs of removal of the driveway shall be the sole responsibility of the offending landowner and if not paid the cost shall be placed on the real estate tax bill of the offending landowner as a special charge.

SECTION 2: Modification

Except as modified herein all other terms of the Town's Driveway Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: Penalties

Any landowner who fails to abide by this ordinance may be fined up to One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per day that the driveway is in violation of the Town's Driveway Ordinance. If not paid this fine may also be added to the offending landowner's real estate tax bill as a special charge.

SECTION 4: Effective Date

This Amendment to the Town's Driveway Ordinance shall be effective after adoption and publication by the Town Board of the Town of Jefferson.
