Prescription pills, patches, ointments, and liquids

Over-the-counter medications, vitamins & liquid

cough medicine | Inhalers | Pet medications

NOT ACCEPTED:

Illegal drugs | Needles/sharps | Thermometers

Personal care products | Epi-pens

How to Dispose of Medications in the Med Drop Boxes:

- ✓ Bring your unused or expired medication to any of the locations listed below. It is important to keep medications original bottles until you are at the Med Drop Box location.
- ✓ Empty contents of pill bottles into a Ziploc/storage bag at the Med Drop Box location and recycle your pill bottles at home. Block out personal information before recycling.
- ✓ Leave liquids, gels or creams in their original containers and place them in a Ziploc/storage bag.
- ✓ Place sealed Ziploc/storage bags into the Med Drop Box.
