**NOTE: Petroleum and petroleum by-products are considered hazardous waste and need to be disposed of properly.**

Compressed Gas Cylinders  
Explosives including Detonators, Blasting caps  
High Pressure Cylinders, Propane or Tanks  
Infectious, Biological Wastes & Needles (sharps)  
Latex Paint & Latex Stains  
Motor Oil  
Radioactive Chemicals and Devices (ie., Smoke Detectors)  
No Electronics  
No Appliances



### Alternative Methods of Disposal

**First and foremost check with the municipality in which you reside. Your municipality may have established recycling in your area.**

Goodwill & St. Vincent accepts Computers/Monitors and computer components for recycling  
- Computer Monitors, CPUs, Printers, Keyboards, Cell Phones, Scanners, ONLY Flat Screen TVs  
St. Vincent does Not Accept Washers & Dryers - No Gas Appliances - No Freon Appliances  
Check with your local Police Department, Fire Station, Sheriff's Department regarding...  
- Ammunition or Explosives  
Check with Recycling Centers regarding Large Appliances  
Check with Automotive Service Centers...  
- regarding Recycling of Motor Oil, Oil Filters, Car Batteries
