Cracksealing to be continued.

Motel Rd needs work.

Equipment in good conditions. Roads and culverts not needing replaced in good condition.

60 Yards of sand in stock for winter. Will need more.

Patching is holding up well from previous years.

Petras Rd needs cracksealed. With short staff and heat, progress is not going as quickly as expected with some road projects. Costs of road projects estimated at about \$30,000 per mile for blacktop and crackseal.

Discuss grant update. \$1.2M for project. Getting pictures and letters of recommendations for grant application. Work would be done 2-3 years from now. Unsure of when approval or denial will be. US Forestry will help with the grant. There may be other grants available if this one id denied.

Applied for additional bridge aid funds. 80ft of culvert on Janacek, Keystone, Petras, among others to be done. Bradley motions to approve, Moore seconds. Motion approved to apply for funds.

Dust suppression on Pagac Rd is being continued.

Sander for winter being considered. Big sander is rusting and deteriorating and is past the point of repairs. Hoping it will last another season.

Discussed looking into buying a truck for town garage.
