# Road Report

- Motel Road culvert required extensive excavation work.
- Two culverts were completed on Petras Road; one removed culvert was sold locally for \$500.
- Blacktop patching completed, including 236 culverts from the previous year.
- Some crack sealing remains; minor cracks still visible in areas.
- Additional sand hauled in for the winter mix; cutting edges for snowplows ordered.
- General maintenance continues.
- Gravel will be hauled from Delta Pit for Spider Lake and Forest Lake roads.
- Approximately 60 yards of salt/sand mix currently in stock for winter use.

#### Other Business

Zoning survey available for review of zoning changes.

- Snowplow driving contracts are being submitted, with additional contracts expected by the end of October deadline.
- Request received to change the name of Forest Road 241 to "Wanoka Lake Road." Motion: Galetka motioned to approve the name change of Forest Road 241 to Wanoka Lake Road; Moore seconded.

Motion carried.

New signs will be ordered, and the county will be notified.

• The town purchased five tables for use at the town hall and outdoor events for \$105 from Moquah Thrift Store.

# Fish Creek Planning

- The board discussed a grant opportunity for improvements to the Fish Creek area.
- Moore suggested seeking community input on how residents would like to see the area developed or improved.
