 - a. Discussion and possible action/approval of a Site plan amendment request for the Kincaid solar project on tax parcels H LG2200001 & H LG2300005, to have all construction traffic access a driveway on US Highway 12, and permanent, post-construction access driveway on Tamarack Rd—requesting to change construction access to and from US highway 12 and then post construction access off of Tamarack Rd, Motion to approve construction access to and from US Highway 12 and the granting of post construction access off of Tamarack Rd, provided posting of a performance bond for the removal of the hardware at the end of its use (Bromley/Anderson) Motion carried.

Discussion and possible action/approval of a variance request for Dan Dietzler, Dietzler Farm LLP, W5556 Meadowlark Dr, HFP 00004, to have a staggered shore stairway with an accessory/viewing corridor of approximately 74.5' in width, the request also includes a variance for a 3' wide walkway parallel to the shoreline 39.84' from the ordinary high-water mark. Walworth County zoning requires a shore stairway to be within the access/viewing corridor of approximately 48.3' on this lot and requires a parallel walkway to be 75' from the ordinary high-water mark—very steep property, hardship presented, increment of relief not very substantial, Motion to approve request as presented, very steep lot, increment of relief is minimal (Bromley/Anderson) Motion carried.
