Title 1 Chapter 3 TOWN OF LAKE MILLS MEETINGS ORDINANCE

- C. PLACE. Any annual or special town meeting shall be held at the Town Hall, 1111 South Main Street, Lake Mills, WI 53551, unless moved pursuant to Section 60.08.
- D. ORDER OF BUSINESS. No reconsideration of any vote shall be had at any town meeting unless it be taken by a majority vote within one hour from the time such vote shall have been passed, or if taken later than one hour, unless it be sustained by a number of votes equal to majority of all the names entered on the poll list at such election up to the time motion therefore shall be made. All other questions upon motions at a town meeting shall be determined by a majority of the electors voting.
- E. PRESIDING OFFICER. At any annual town meeting held in April of a year where the office of the chairperson if filled by election, the person holding that office on the day prior to the date of the election held to fill said office shall be the presiding officer. If said person is absent or refuses to serve, one of the other supervisors of the town shall serve as chairperson; but if no one of the supervisors be present the qualified electors at such meeting may choose a chairperson.
- F. CLERK OF MEETING. The Town Clerk shall be clerk of such town meeting; but if they be absent, then such person shall be appointed by the Town Board to act at clerk of such meetings.

1-3-3: SPECIAL TOWN MEETINGS:

- 1. PURPOSE. Special town meetings may be held for the purpose of transacting any lawful business which might be done at the annual meeting. No matter voted upon or decided at any such special town meeting shall be acted upon in any subsequent special town meeting held in such town prior to the time for holding the next annual town meeting.
- HOW CALLED. Special town meetings may be held pursuant to a request being made to the town Clerk in writing signed by a number of electors equal to not less than 10% of the votes cast in the town for governor at the last general election or by action of the Town Board, specifying the purposes for which such meeting is to be held.
- 3. NOTICE. The Town Clerk with whom the request is left shall record it, set the date, and place for the meeting, and not sooner than twenty (20), nor less than fifteen (15) days before the date of the meeting, publish a Class 2 notice, under Chapter 985.
- 4. CONTENTS OF NOTICE. The notice shall state the purpose, date, and place of the meeting.
- 1-3-4: SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

1-3-5: ADOPTION AND AMENDNENTS: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its date of adoption and publication as provided by law.
