PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR BOATS ON MUD LAKE, BEAN LAKE, AND HOPE LAKE

SECTION:

5-8-1: Mud Lake 5-8-2: Hope Lake 5-8-3: Bean Lake 5-8-4: Definition 5-8-5: Penalties

- 5-8-1: MUD LAKE: No person shall operate a motor boat or manually propel a boat equipped with a gasoline powered motor on Mud Lake including the outlet from Mud Lake to C.T.H. "A" in the Town of Lake Mills, Jefferson County, Wisconsin.
- 5-8-2: HOPE LAKE: No person shall operate a motor boat or manually propel a boat equipped with a gasoline powered motor on that portion of Hope Lake located in the Town of Lake Mills, Jefferson County, Wisconsin.
- 5-8-3: BEAN LAKE: No person shall operate a motor boat or manually propel a boat equipped with a gasoline powered motor on Bean Lake in the Town of Lake Mills, Jefferson County, Wisconsin.
- 5-8-4: DEFINITION: A "motor boat" means any boat propelled by machinery, whether or not such machinery is the principle source of propulsion.
- 5-8-5: PENALTIES: The most current State of Wisconsin Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule for Boating Violations is hereby incorporated by reference. Any person violating any provisions of this ordinance not covered under the most current Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule for boating violations shall forfeit not more than \$50.00 for the first offense and shall forfeit not more than \$100.00 upon the conviction of the same offense a second or subsequent time within one year. In addition, said persons shall also be responsible for any costs of prosecution.
