## ROAD REPORT

Mike will be talking to Dewar about snowplowing again for next year, will bring up at next meeting. Brush cutting on west side of K was done last month. Ryan King is filling potholes, did some this morning and will do more tomorrow. Matt Leder said someone had called about the snowplowing had scraped up some gravel onto the grass, this is not in our policy because it is in the road right of way. Matt Leder also reported that someone had called about cable on their property left by Frontier. Frontier was contacted but they have not gotten back to us. Weight limits are off, possibly by beginning of April to go back on, it depends upon the weather. Mike talked to Dewar about getting one of his guys to use our grader or Dewar's guy using one of their graders to grade the roads this summer.
