DOG LICENSE:

All dog owners must license their dogs every year. License fees are as follows: Male or Female \$8.00 Neutered or Spayed \$3.00 Kennel (6 to 12 dogs) \$35.00*** Mail Rabies Vaccination Certificate (required by law and will be returned to you)

and the license fee (separate from TAX

payment) to Pearl Schicker Town of Metomen, Treasurer

UNPAID dog licenses will be monitored and collected with penalty (by WI Statutes)

***KENNEL DOG LICENSE ORDINANCE:

You must get Town Board approval to obtain your kennel license at a monthly town board meeting. A Kennel License is required for 6-12 dogs on site.

Tax Collection: We encourage you to pay by mail to avoid waiting in **person.** Payment amounts are included on the payment stubs located at the bottom of your tax

bill. Enclose the appropriate payment stubs with your payment. Mail payments to the location listed on the payment stub (note December/January address is DIFFERENT than the July payment address). Please do not enclose the original tax bill. A self-addressed stamped envelope is required if you want a receipt.

Payments will be accepted in the form of a check, cashier's check or money order. Certify that an escrow check meets or exceeds the tax bill amount and endorse the escrow check.

WARNING: If payment is not made by the due dates, the installment option is lost and the total tax is delinquent and subject to interest and penalty. See the reverse side of your property tax bill for a complete explanation.

***BUILDING PERMITS *** A land use permit is required for all new buildings (including Agricultural buildings), remodeling, etc. If you need a permit or are unsure if you need a permit for work being done: Call Sue Leahy 920-229-6360 for more information. Forms are available in town website

Before ditching, draining, or tilling any lands that may be zoned wetland by County Ordinance, contact your Town Board.

FARMLAND PRESERVATION INFORMATION – All participants will need to meet all of the Agriculture Performance Standards, complete a Certificate of Compliance and then have it signed by the Land and Water Conservation Department by the end 2018. Contact the Land and Water Conservation Dept at 920/923-3033 ext. 3 for details.

POWTS Special Assessment: Pursuant to Resolution Number 124-09, adopted by the Fond du Lac County Board of Supervisors on March 16, 2010, and effective on the 2018 property tax bill, Fond du Lac County will apply a special assessment fee of \$7.00 for each Private Onsite Wastewater Treatment System (POWTS) in Fond du Lac County. If you are a tax-exempt organization (i.e. church or governmental unit), you will still receive the charge of \$7.00 per POWTS since this is a special assessment, not a tax. If you feel this information is in error, please call the Fond du Lac County Code Enforcement Office at 920-929-3139. Please leave your name, address of the property, phone number, and why you feel this assessment is in error.
