

Enrollment Verification (If expired)



Valid for voting if the opiration date is no more than 2 years from the date to card was issued. If expired, must be accompanied with arrent enrollment verification

Can be expired since November 3, 2020 (currently the last General Election)

State of Wisconsin ID Card







Can be expired since November 3, 2020 (currently the last General Election)

Veterans Affairs ID



Must be unexpired or have no expiration

Tribal ID Card



Still valid for voting if expired

U.S. Passport Book or Card



Can be expired since
November 3, 2020

Only valid for voting if Certificate wa issued not more than 2 years before t date of the election
