## WHAT IS RECYCLABLE?

### **PLASTICS (all #1-7)**

- plastic containers
- yogurt cups
- ketchup/mustard bottles
- tubs, bottles, jugs & detergent containers

### **GLASS JARS & BOTTLES**

- jars & bottles of any color

### **CARDBOARD/PAPER**

- newspapers, shiny inserts
- magazines and catalogs
- any type of corrugated boxes
- pressed paper & office paper
- soda, pizza, & beer boxes
- egg cartons & phone books
- mail, junk mail & envelopes (plastic windows are OK)
- cereal, cracker, & snack boxes
- toothpaste, soap & detergent boxes
- cards, gift wrap (no tissue or foil paper)
- shredded paper (place in paper bag or clear plastic bag)

### **CARTONS-FOOD & BEVERAGE**

- milk cartons (dairy, soy, almond)
- juice, soup, broth & wine cartons

### **METAL**

- aluminum, tin, steel cans
- empty aerosol cans, empty paint cans/lids
- aluminum foil, pie plates, containers (cannot be soiled with food)
- wire clothes hangers
- christmas lights, extension cords, electrical wiring (no coaxial cable)

## **Other Non-Recyclable Items Accepted:**

Sealed Lead Acid (vehicle type) batteries (accepted at BBC & M and City of Mondovi sites only) Other rechargeable-type batteries can be recycled with electronics (fee may apply) or discarded in the garbage per the WI Department of Natural Resources.

## **ELECTRONICS Recycling\***

Computer Items, T.V.'s and Other Electronics Are Accepted at the BBC & M and City of Mondovi Sites During Normal Recycling Hours. Please note that there are recycling charges associated with many of these electronics items. See County website for more details.

## **Building (Construction) Materials**

Accepted at BBC & M and City of Mondovi sites only.

## **Household Hazardous Materials:**

Accepted only during County "Clean Sweep" events which are held as grant funding comes available. These will be noticed on the County Recycling Website. For Other Questions Contact: LaCrosse County Haz Waste Collection Center (608)785-9999 Waste Research and Reclamation, Eau Claire (715)834-9624

Note: latex paint cans can be allowed to dry out and disposed of in the trash. Dried plastic paint containers can be recycled.
