Section 1

PURPOSE

The Town of Moira has determined that use of ATVs as defined in the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York should be allowed to operate on designated Town highways to enable operators to gain access to areas and trails within the Town of Moira open to ATV use as well as trails and areas including Town highways open to ATV use in adjoining Towns.

Section 2

DESIGNATION OF TOWN HIGHWAYS PURSUANT TO THE NEW YORK STATE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAWS SECTION 2405

The Town of Moira does hereby designate as open for travel by ATVs the following Town highways or portions thereof, which the Town has determined are necessary to allow ATV operators to gain access to areas or trails adjoining said Town highways:

Alburg Road	2.04 miles
Barrett Road	1.10 miles
Best Road	3.75 miles
Brigham Hill Road	1.19 miles
Chandler Road	1.76 miles
Clark Road	2.08 miles
Dow Road	1.04 miles
Elmer Road	1.30 miles
Finnegan Road	1.30 miles
John Hill Road	1.60 miles
Mahoney Road	1.33 miles
Mill Street55 miles
North Wood Road	1.61 miles
O'Connell Road76 miles
Perry Road83 miles
Patterson Road	1.66 miles
Russell Road	1.79 miles
Savage Road	1.23 miles
Saxton Road	1.50 miles

Section 3

SIGNS AND MARKERS

Said Town highways shall only be open to ATV operators, when they have been identified by signs or markers in such manner as may be provided by Rules and Regulations of the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles and/or the New York State Department of Transportation.

Section 4

HOURS OF OPERATION

ATVs shall only be operated on designated Town highways between the hours of 6 A.M. to 12:00 midnight.

Section 5

VIOLATIONS

Any person who violates any provision of this Local Law or of Articles 48-B and 48-C of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York shall be guilty of a traffic infraction as provided in Section 2289 of said Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.

Section 6

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall be effective upon filing the same with the Department of State and with the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles.
