## **EXHIBIT "A"**

### **ARTICLE 1 - TITLE**

The title of this law shall be the "Grievance Day Law for the Town of Moira."

### **ARTICLE 2 - PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Local Law is to provide for the holding of Grievance Day on the first Thursday following the fourth Tuesday of May.

### **ARTICLE 3 - AUTHORITY**

This Local Law is enacted pursuant to Section 512 of the Real Property Tax Law.

### **ARTICLE 4 - DEFINITIONS**

"Grievance Day" means the date on which the Town of Moira Board of Assessment Review shall meet to hear complaints in relation to assessments.

### **ARTICLE 5 - DATE ESTABLISHED**

The Town of Moira hereby adopts as and for its Grievance Day the first Thursday following the fourth Tuesday of May and so may days thereafter as the Board of Assessment Review deems necessary in order for such Board to hear complaints in relation to assessments pursuant to Section 512 of the New York State Real Property Tax Law.

### **ARTICLE 6 - SEVERABILITY**

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this Local Law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

### **ARTICLE 7 - REPEAL**

All ordinances, local laws, and regulations inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby repealed.

### **ARTICLE 8 - EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Local Law shall become effective immediately upon filing with the State of New York Secretary of State.
