Resolution 02-02-2016, Requesting Pedestrian Sidewalk Accommodations for the Highway PB Bridge, over the Sugar River

The Town of Montrose, Dane County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and orders as follows:

WHEREAS, Dane County ("County") in conjunction with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation ("WisDOT"), has determined that the County Highway PB Bridge (Paoli Road) over the Sugar River, Project ID 5658-00-06, is in need of reconstruction ("the Project"): and

WHEREAS, 23 U.S.C. Wis. Stats. 217(g) requires that projects receiving federal funds shall give due consideration to the inclusion of bicycle and pedestrian facilities in projects that receive federal funds; and

WHEREAS, The State of Wisconsin requires that a municipality in which a transportation project funded in whole or in part by state funds is being constructed, must first pass a resolution authorizing the inclusion of pedestrian or bicycle facilities; and

WHEREAS, The Town requests that the COUNTY include the construction of sidewalks on both sides of the County Highway PB Bridge as part of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Town agrees that cost sharing will be as identified in the COUNTY's policy "Joint Projects with Municipalities".

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Montrose Board, in legal session assembled, does hereby approve and authorized the COUNTY and WISDOT to include raised sidewalks on both sides of the County Highway PB bridge as part of the Project.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
