Ordinance 12-03-2019

An Ordinance to Approve the Conversion of Town Clerk and Town Treasurer from an Elected Office to an Appointed Office

The Town Board of the Town of Montrose, Dane County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows: That, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 60.30(1e)(a), the office of the town clerk and the office of town treasurer shall each be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the town board. The term of office for the appointed positions shall be set by the town board, but may not exceed 3 years per § 60.30(1e)(c), Wis. Stats.. The town board may re-appoint the officers for additional terms. However, removal by the town board during a given term of office may only be for "cause" as defined under § 17.001 Wis. Stats. and required by § 60.30(1e)(f) Wis. Stats. This ordinance is subject to approval by the town electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the Town Board to be held on April 7, 2020.

The referendum questions shall be:

"Shall the person holding the office of town clerk in the Town of Montrose be appointed by the Town Board in the Town of Montrose?"

and

"Shall the person holding the office of town treasurer be appointed by the Town Board in the Town of Montrose?"

The salary of the appointed positions shall be set by the Town Board and may not be reduced during the term of office.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its town board passage, notice after passage per § 60.80 Wis. Stats. and also, its referendum approval by the town electors as required by §60.30(1e)(b) Wis. Stats.
