- County Radio System Upgrade
 - The County will purchase all required mobiles, portables, and pagers for public safety agencies. Any equipment needed in the future will be the responsibility of the municipality.
 - Current total price to replace NFR equipment is \$140,220.00
 - The County will cover all future maintenance of the system going forward.
 - Municipalities will be responsible for biennial preventative maintenance of devices that are part of the system. As of today, that cost is figured at approximately \$65 per device every other year. Please see the attached for the projected estimate for each department/municipality
 - As of now this would be about \$4,485.00 every two years or \$2,242.50 every year
