## **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING VILLAGE POWERS**

## Town of Norrie, Marathon County

The town meeting of the Town of Norrie, Marathon County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors voting at the special town meeting (with notice) assembled and voting, resolves and orders as follows:

Pursuant to section 60.10 (2) (c) of the Wisconsin statutes, the Town Board of the Town of Norrie is authorized to exercise powers of a village board under section 60.22 (3) of the Wisconsin statutes which power shall be a general and continuing power for the board. This resolution supersedes and replaces any and all town ordinance(s) regarding the authorization of village powers which may have previously been in effect.

This resolution may be rescinded at any subsequent town electors meeting by a vote of at least the same number of electors who voted to grant the powers in the first place.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under section 60.80 of the Wisconsin statutes within 30 days of the below-noted adoption date.
