REQUEST FOR ROAD PROJECT BIDS

The Town of Oakfield is seeking sealed bids for two road resurfacing projects and two sealcoating projects. The first project consists of the resurfacing of an approximate .5 mile section of Highland Road, between Breakneck Road and Kinwood Road. The second project consists of the resurfacing of an approximate .5 mile section of Prairie Road, between Wolf Road and Fountain Road.

Both projects will involve the addition of 4 inches of $\frac{3}{4}$ inch road gravel lift, the pulverizing of the existing asphalt with the added gravel including shaping and compacting to a width of 20 ft., the placement of a compacted 2 inch hot-mix asphalt mat with the addition of 2 ft. wide gravel shoulders.

The two sealcoating projects consist of a .77 mile section of Johnson Road and a 1.00 mile section of Wolf Road.

The hot-mix asphalt shall be bid on a per ton price for material laid in place and compacted. Material shall meet Wisconsin DOT specifications for moderate volume roads. The pulverizing of existing pavement, shaping and compacting shall be bid on a square yard price, with a total price for the project. Gravel material shall be bid on a per ton basis for both the base and shoulders. Sealcoating shall be bid on a per mile basis, with a separate quote for any recommended patching. Contractors are to supply all labor, material, traffic control, signing and proof of insurance.

The Town of Oakfield reserves the right to reject any or all bids or part of bids and accept any bid, which in the judgment of the Town Board, may be most advantageous to the Town. Bids will be publicly opened and acted upon at 7:00 p.m. on Monday,

June 6, 2011 at the Town Hall in Oak Center. The bidders are reminded that the work must be completed to State of Wisconsin DOT standards. Also, the bidder's attention is called to the fact that the Highland and Prairie Road Projects are subject to a prevailing wage rate determination which has been issued by the State of Wisconsin and that the prevailing wage rates and hours of labor set forth in this determination shall be applicable to these projects.
