US 14 Bridges Project

Oregon to Fitchburg, 2020-2021

September 2019

Project Info

US 14 bridge improvement work is scheduled to begin in the spring of 2020 between Oregon and Fitchburg. The project will repair or replace a total of 6 bridges located at WIS 138, County MM, Byrne Road and McCoy Road. Work will be suspended during the winter months and resume in 2021.

In 2020 the work will occur at the WIS 138 interchange and County MM. Work in 2021 will occur at Byrne Road and McCoy Road.

Traffic Impacts

US 14 will remain open to traffic during construction with single lane closures. Temporary closures with detours are planned at the following US 14 access locations:

Spring 2020

- WIS 138 **closed** between the roundabouts under US 14. Eastbound WIS 138 traffic detoured using US 14 to WIS 59 to WIS 138. Westbound WIS 138 traffic must use County MM or alternate routes
- US 14 bridge **closed** at WIS 138, traffic routed through the roundabouts

Summer 2020

• Single lane on US 14 bridge over County MM.

Spring 2021

- Byrne Road closed between South Syene and County MM
- County MM on-ramp to US 14 westbound closed

Summer 2021

- Lacy Road westbound on-ramp **closed**
- McCoy Road closed nightly 7 pm-5am
- Single lane closures on US 14

Fall 2021

- Lacy Road westbound on-ramp closed.
- McCoy Road between US 14 on ramps **closed** nightly 7 pm-5 am
