RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ADJUSTMENT TO THE MUNICIPAL LEVY LIMIT  
FOR INCREASES IN CHARGES ASSESSED BY THE BROOKLYN FIRE AND EMS  
PROTECTION DISTRICT INC.

WHEREAS, an adjustment to the municipal levy limit is allowed for increases in charges assessed by the joint fire and emergency medical services departments organized under Wisconsin Statute 66.0602(3)(h) for each governing body served by the joint departments, and

WHEREAS, the allowable adjustment is as follows:


The percentage increase in the total charges assessed by the joint fire and emergency medical services departments for the current year relative to the total charges assessed by the joint departments for the previous year, must be less than or equal to the Consumer Price Index for urban customers, U.S. City average, as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor for the preceding 12 months ending on August 31 in the year of the levy, plus two percent.

WHEREAS, each governing body served by the joint departments must adopt a resolution in favor of the increase in charges;

WHEREAS, the Village of Brooklyn, Town of Brooklyn, Town of Oregon, Town of Rutland and Town of Union are governing bodies served by the Brooklyn Fire and EMS Protection District, Inc.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Town of Oregon, Dane County, Wisconsin, approve an adjustment may be added to the tax levy limit for increases in charges for fire services assessed by the Brooklyn Fire and EMS Protection District, Inc., as determined above for the 2022 tax levy.
