

At a Regular Monthly Meeting of the Town Board held in and for the Town of Oswego on the 9th day of April, 2024 at 6:00 PM at the Oswego Town Hall, 2130 County Route 7, Oswego, New York.

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-49

PURSUANT TO TOWN LAW § 170 and § 172-f ESTABLISH A FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the entire Town of Oswego is presently encompassed by the existing Town of Oswego Fire District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Town of Oswego Fire District, in conjunction with the Town Board of the Town of Oswego, may diminish the Fire District's boundaries pursuant to Town Law § 172-f; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Oswego Fire District will no longer be responsible for providing fire protection to areas that have been excluded from the Fire District via the diminution of the Fire District's borders; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board must create a fire protection district in the areas that are excluded from an existing fire district via the diminution process in accordance with Town Law § 172-f; and

WHEREAS, the Town has reviewed the proposal to diminish the Town of Oswego Fire District and proposes to consider forming a new fire protection district called the Campus Fire Protection District over the portion of the Town no longer provided fire protection by the Town of Oswego Fire District; and

WHEREAS, this newly proposed Campus Fire Protection District is to encompass all of that area of the Town that is not provided fire protection by the Town of Oswego Fire District, as further described in **SCHEDULE A**, attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Town of Oswego to be in the public interest of this Town to consider forming a new fire protection district over the portions of the Town that are not provided fire protection by the Town of Oswego Fire District as described in **SCHEDULE A**, upon the diminution of the existing Town of Oswego Fire District on or about December 26, 2023; and

NOW THEREFORE,

It is hereby **RESOLVED** that the Town of Oswego shall provide notice of and host a public hearing on whether to form the new Campus Fire Protection District over the portions of the Town that are not provided fire protection by the Town of Oswego Fire District, as described in **SCHEDULE A**. The public hearing shall be held on May 14, 2024 at the Oswego Town Hall

located at 2320 Co. Rte. 7, Oswego, NY, 13126 upon the conclusion of a prior public hearing upon the diminution of the existing Town of Oswego Fire District, but in no event earlier than 6:00 pm.

The estimated rate per thousand dollars of assessed valuation, based on the aggregate assessed valuation of taxable real property of the proposed fire protection district shown in the latest completed final assessment roll, projected to be assessed, levied and collected for purposes of the proposed fire protection district for the fiscal year of its operation, of the property located in the territory listed in Schedule A is \$0 based upon a taxable value of the proposed fire protection district of \$0.

It is further **RESOLVED** that notice of such hearing be provided in accordance with Town Law §§ 170(2) and 171(2) and the clerk of this municipality is directed to cause such notice to be given by publishing notice of the hearing in a newspaper having general circulation in the proposed Campus Fire Protection District at least once, and posting such notice conspicuously in the Town of Oswego, the first publication and post of which is not less than ten (10) days nor more than twenty (20) days before the date of the hearing. The clerk also shall post the notice on the sign-board of the Town maintained pursuant to subdivision six of section thirty of Article 11 of the Town Law, not less than ten (10) nor more than twenty (20) days prior to the hearing. The clerk also shall serve each member of this board with such notice by mailing such notice to the address of each member at their last known post office address, at least ten (10) days before the date of the hearing.

This resolution having been made by Councilor Herrmann and seconded by Councilor Weimer has received the affirmative vote of at least a majority of the Board of the Town of Oswego, as noted below and such resolution is hereby approved.
