



# MENTAL HYGIENE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

Transportation service for adults and youth with mental health and/or substance abuse disorders who experience travel challenges - This service will help consistently access and engage in services & supports essential for healthy development, illness management, recovery, and community living.

- Mental Health Clinic, Counseling & Treatment Appts.
- Substance Abuse Services/Support Appts.
- Open Access hours/locations for SUD or MH Treatment
- Clubhouse, Recovery, & Senior Centers
- Community Agency/Service Locations
- Intensive Crisis Stabilization Center in Onondaga County (one way driver available)
- Primary Care Appts.
- Support/Teaching Groups, Self-Help Meetings (NA & AA)
- RX pickup at pharmacy
- Dept. of Social Services to manage benefits
- Social Security Determination Appts in Syr.
- Food Pantries
- Planned Residential Respite Services (crisis respite if driver availability)
- Parent Participation at School (Head Start - Grade 12)
- SPOA Meetings
- Intervention Court, Drug Treatment Court, Court Related Drug Testing
