WHEREAS, the Town Board deems it necessary and in the best interests of the Town that, pursuant to the provisions of Section 67.12(12) Wisconsin Statues, the sum of \$743,836.56 for such purposes upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED for the purpose hereinabove set for the by the Town, by its President and Clerk pursuant to Section 67.12(12), borrow from First Citizens State Bank-Palmyra Branch the sum of \$743,836.56 and to evidence such indebtedness, said President and Clerk shall make, execute and deliver to the Lender for and on behalf of the Town the promissory note of the Town to be dated October 13, 2021 in said principal amount with interest at the rate of 2.75% per annum and payable as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there be, and there herby is, levied on all the taxable property of the Town, a direct annual irrepealable tax sufficient in amount to pay the principal and interest on said note as the same becomes due and payable, said tax to be in the following minimum amounts:
