TOWN OF PALMYRA, WI ORDINANCE NO. 2022-005

Ordinance Lowering the Speed Limit on Tamarack Road Town of Palmyra, Jefferson County, Wisconsin

The Town Board of the Town of Palmyra, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. Stats, to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain Town highways in the Town of Palmyra as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis Stats, effective July 12, 2022, speed limits on certain Town of Palmyra town highways are reduced or modified as follows:
 - The Town of Palmyra road known as Tamarack Road, beginning at the Town limit and extending to the County line, is reduced to 35 miles per hour.
- B. Pursuant to s. 349.11(5), Wis stats, the Town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. Stats.

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting or July 12, 2022.

The Town of Palmyra clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis.
