TOWN OF PALMYRA, WI ORDINANCE NO. 2023-002

Ordinance CREATION OF A FIVE MEMBER BOARD

The Town Board of the Town of Palmyra, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under 60.10(2)(c), 60.21(1) and 60.22(3), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance to establish a 5-member board.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I: PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to provide greater representation to the residents of the Town of Palmyra via a five-member board.

SECTION II: ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

Pursuant to authorization under 60.21(1), Wis. stats., the Town Board of the Town of Palmyra, Jefferson County, elects to create a 5-member town board as follows:

For the spring election, in April 2024, Supervisor 3 and Supervisor 4 will be elected for two-year terms. Supervisor 3 and Supervisor 4 will remain on the even year election rotation, every two years. The Chairman of the Board and Supervisor 1 and Supervisor 2 will remain on the odd year election rotation, every two years.

SECTION III: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage, posting and publication as provided under s. <u>60.80</u>, Wis. Stats.
