

TOWN OF PALMYRA, WI ORDINANCE NO. 2023-003

Ordinance REGULATING HEAVY TRUCK ROUTES IN THE TOWN OF PALMYRA

The Town Board of the Town of Palmyra, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.17, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance and does hereby ordain as follows:

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designates town highways as heavy traffic routes in the town as follows:

A. In this ordinance, "heavy traffic" means all vehicles not operating completely on pneumatic tires and all vehicles or combination of vehicles, other than motor buses, designed or used for transporting property of any nature and having a gross weight of more than 6,000 pounds.

B. The following Town of Palmyra highways are designated as heavy traffic routes and heavy traffic on the following town highways is restricted or prohibited as follows:

State Trunk Highway 59, State Trunk Highway 106, County Trunk Highway E, County Trunk Highway H, County Trunk Highway Z, Little Prairie Road are designated truck routes pursuant to § 349.17(1), Wis. Stats.


C. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.*

D. No person may operate any vehicle on the above noted town highways in violation of the above noted designated heavy traffic routes. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.04(2) Wis. Stats.

This ordinance becomes effective after publication and appropriate signs have been posted.

The town clerk shall properly publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.


