Dog Licenses for Village of Pelham residents:

Click here for our application. You'll also need proof of current rabies and proof of spay/neuter. To renew, only the application and proof of current rabies is necessary. Why get a dog license? (1) required by law (2) to reunite lost dogs (3) required for off leash dog parks in Westchester County.



County Clerk Van:

The Westchester County Clerk Van will be available for a variety of services, including passports, free notary, business certificate applications & acceptance of veterans discharge papers. Passport applications require form DS-11 (complete in advance to save time), proof of citizenship, a photo ID, passport photo, check/money order for payment. Photos taken on site for additional fee.
