RESOLUTION NO. 10-2021

Resolution Regarding Municipal Water Service and the Town of Peshtigo

- WHEREAS, the Town of Peshtigo adopted a Resolution on or about October 20, 2020 stating an intent to work with the City of Marinette to determine whether the City of Marinette will provide municipal water service to the Town of Peshtigo; and
- WHEREAS, approximately eight months have passed since adoption of that Resolution and neither the Mayor of Marinette or the Common Council for the City of Marinette have ' received any contact from the Town of Peshtigo. Despite reports in the community, there has been no active communication from the Town of Peshtigo to the City of Marinette over the last eight months; and
- WHEREAS, the Common Council for the City of Marinette has a duty to protect the best interests of City residents and taxpayers; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Marinette adopts this Resolution to clear up any confusion in the community and to affirmatively state that the City of Marinette has no interest in expanding its municipal water service outside of the City of Marinette or to the Town of Peshtigo. Furthermore, the City of Marinette has no interest in supplying wholesale water to the Town of Peshtigo; and
- WHEREAS, the City recommends the Town of Peshtigo focus on a POET water system, contracting with the City of Peshtigo for municipal water service or review other solutions for the Town's water source.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Marinette, Wisconsin as follows:
 - The City of Marinette is not interested in providing municipal water service or wholesale water to the Town of Peshtigo.
 - The City recommends that the Town explore other options for obtaining water service for Town residents.
