WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Town of Polk, Washington County, to invest its funds in a legal and safe manner and conform to applicable federal, state, and local statutes; and

WHERAS, Resolution 2011-02: A Resolution Designating a Public Depository for the Town of Polk, Washington County was adopted February 17, 2011 designating Commerce State Bank as the Public Depository; and

WHEREAS, Establishment of a separate bank account is recommended by federal and state guidelines to insure accurate accounting and reporting of American Rescue Plan Grant funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this Resolution, adopted by a majority on the Town Board of Polk, resolves and orders the Treasurer to establish a public bank account for money received from the American Rescue Plan Grant only.
