Animals

The Towns Animal Ordinace requres dogs to be on a leash when off of the owners property. Town ordinance and State statute require ALL dogs 5 months and older to be licensed and be able to show proof of current rabies vaccination.

Parking

Parking in the right of way is restricted. Spruce Lane is no parking on both sides of the road from B to the lake. This is an emergency access area. In event of emergency, vehicles blocking access will be moved.

Snow

Snow season is up us. Please be aware it is illegal to leave snow in the road after plowing. Sherrif's depart will issue fines.

Winnebago County maintains all county roads. Town roads are maintained by Radtke South of B and All Ways Concrete North of B.

Pay by Mail

Pay by Drop Box

Drop payments at the drop box located on the brick pillar near the main entrance.

Payments dropped off before 12/31/25 at midnight will be receipted for 2025. Any received after will be receipted in 2026 regardless of check date.

Pay Online

Credit/Debit payment option for TAXES only NO dog licenses.

All fees charged to use the credit card are the taxpayer's responsibility.

All payments need to be made prior to 11:59 am CST on January 30, 2026. The credit card feature will be turned off at 12:00 PM CST (noon).

- Payments made after February 1 should be made payable & mailed to Winnebago County
- Town will charge payer \$25 for returned/NSF checks. Town will provide opportunity to pay by cash or certified check. Otherwise tax payment will be voided.
- Refunds for payments in excess of tax will be mailed on January 22, 2026 & February 18, 2026.
- Please contact Treasurer with tax bill address changes.
- Lottery Credits. If you lived at primary residence on January 1, 2025 and you did not receive a lottery credit on bill, you can fill out the form online at https://ww2.revenue.wi.gov/VaultPublic/lc/interview.html or contact Treasurer (info above) for form and credit on your taxes.

DOG LICENSE

Annual licensing of dogs is required by State Statute & Town Ordinance.

Cost per animal: \$5 spayed/Neutered \$10 Not Spayed/Neutered

Submit application with

- 1. Completed Application
- 2. Copy of CURRENT Rabies Vaccine Certificate.
- 3. Payment in SEPARATE Check

Late fee of \$10 per dog for each license issued after March 31.
