Resolution to Discontinue Portion of Town Road

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Prairie Lake Barron County

The Town Board of the Town of Prairie Lake, Barron County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the Town Board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and declares as follows:

The public way described below will be discontinued and vacated under s. 66.1003(4), Wis. Stats. It is in the public interest that the public way described below is vacated and discontinued under s. 66.1003 (4), Wis. Stats. Said public way has never been used or worked by the Town or the public.

The public way to be discontinued is described as follows:

A part of a Town Road as platted in New Rockford, located in Government Lot 2 of Section 3, T. 33 N., R. 11 W., Town of Prairie Lake, Barron County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as:

Commencing at the East 1/4 Corner of said Section 3;

thence S89°55'06"W, 839.94 feet; thence N 00°45'56"W, 1313.38 feet to the Point of

Beginning;

thence S 88°09'43"W, 57.74 feet; thence N 85°40'01"W, 116.00 feet;

thence N 86°49'50"E, 173.43 feet;

thence S 00°45'56"E, 16.50 feet to the Point of Beginning.

Attached as Exhibit A is a map showing the portion of said right of way to be discontinued.

The discontinuance of the above-described public way will not result in a landlocked property and no owner of property abutting the discontinued public way will be damaged by the discontinuance.

The discontinued public way will be vacated and the land awarded to the owner or owners of real estate abutting the discontinued way per s. 66.1005 Wis. Stats.

The Town Clerk shall properly publish notice of this resolution and hearing date as a Class 3 notice as required pursuant to s. 66.1003 Wis. Stats.


