Soils/Inert Material/High BTU (In) <small>See Notes 8,9</small>	\$ 100.00 - \$250.00/ton

Confidential Burns (IN) <small>See Note 9</small>	\$ 80.00/ton - \$30.00 Min.

### Notes:

1. Fees are in \$ per ton unless noted. All loads must be weighed & weight recorded.
2. Tires larger than 10.00 x 20 may have a cutting charge of up to \$20.00 per cut. Extremely large tires or tracks charged more.
3. Reduced rates (when available) vary and are normally in effect from December to March.
4. Items must be separated by customer for reduced \$65.00 fee. (Sheet rock, shingles and other items must be separated from burnables)
5. This rate applies to loads that are exclusively yard waste. Mixed loads are at higher rate.
6. Load/tonnage rates apply but up to five items per household included in each load or Load charge plus \$5.00 each for each item from businesses and commercial sources and 6+ from households.
7. Electronic wastes that are partially recycled or broken will be denied or charged a minimum of \$20 each. Example stripped or broken CRT's.
8. Facility Manager will have discretion within these ranges and will base fees on heat value, dust levels, special handling required, etc.
9. By appointment only. Usually only accepted on Mondays or Tuesdays before 9:00 AM.

### General Conditions:

All wastes must meet US Environmental Protection Agency and Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources regulations, Barron County Flow Control Ordinance provisions and Waste-To-Energy Facility requirements. Barron County shall make the final determination as to the acceptability of waste. **All loads must be covered while on public roads in Barron County.**

**All Trucks & Trailers must be Weighed.** Mixed Loads will always be charged at the highest rate or pro-rated when possible. The Customer is responsible for placing different materials in locations as directed by Staff.

**The Customer is responsible for unloading of material.** An additional fee of \$50.00 will be charged for unloading materials. (The attendant may assist by pulling loads off with the loader if time allows and the customer assumes responsibility for any and all damages that may result). The Customer is responsible for any damage they do to their own vehicle, or any other property, public or private.
