

The Town of Prairie Lake had a tornado touch down slightly north of 10th Avenue on both sides of lake last night. There is an excessive amount of tree fall. Many Prairie Lake homes and property were affected. Our hearts go out to those who suffered from this storm.

Clean-up will begin today. The Town of Prairie Lake does not have a place for tree debris from the storm; however, we will assess the extent of damage this morning and take actions as needed to accelerate clean up.

Jerry's Tree Service does have a brush pile site south of the City of Chetek that can be used to discard tree debris and the Barron County Incinerator will accept tree debris but not tree stumps.

Our road crew will be working today to clear remaining road ways and public areas and boat landings.

The Town extends its thanks to hundreds of first responders from local Fire Departments and Ambulance Services who took care of the injured. We also say thank you to all the utility workers who restored power to the area before morning. And finally, thanks to those of you who took care of your neighbors last night.
