

**INVITATION TO BID
TOWN OF PROSPECT, CONNECTICUT
State Route 69
Sidewalk Extension & Pedestrian-Level Illumination
Prospect, Connecticut 06712**

The Town of Prospect, Connecticut (Town) is seeking bids from qualified contractors to furnish all materials, labor, equipment and incidentals thereto for construction roadway work as shown on plans for State Route 69 Sidewalk Extension & Pedestrian-Level Illumination. Work will be funded by a CTDOT Small Town Economic Assistance Program and all work and record keeping shall conform to program requirements. The work to be performed under this contract includes, but is not limited to, the following items:

- Contact “Call Before You Dig” prior to the start of construction.
- Obtain CTDOT Encroachment Permit
- Install Sedimentation and Erosion Control measures.
- Perform concrete sidewalk construction including excavation, compacted base, etc.
- Perform related work incidental to project.
- Construction activities shall take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- Maintenance and protection of traffic shall be coordinated with the Town of Prospect and CTDOT.
- Secure the necessary permits and bonds and maintain required insurance.
- Clean-up, disposal of waste and debris, and restoration of work site to original condition and to the satisfaction of the Town of Prospect, CTDOT and the Engineer.
- All other related work required to complete the project.

Sealed bids for “State Route 69 Sidewalk Extension & Pedestrian-Level Illumination – Bid Proposal” will be received at the Town Hall, Town of Prospect, 36 Center Street, Prospect, Connecticut 06712, no later than 9:30 a.m., local time on September 22nd, 2026.

Each bid shall be accompanied by one (1) of the following forms of security: a cashier’s check; a certified check; or a bid bond, which security shall be made payable to the Town of Prospect and shall be in an amount equal to ten (10%) percent of the amount bid. Any bid bond submitted as security shall be in the form provided for such bid bond in the bid package documents and such bid bond shall be executed and issued by a surety company acceptable to the Town of Prospect. Any bid that does not contain the above requisite security or any bid that contains security that does not comply with the foregoing requirements, shall be rejected as non-responsive.

Bids will be opened publicly at the above referenced Town of Prospect offices at the time and date that bids are due. The Town of Prospect reserves the right to reject any or all of the bids, or any part(s) thereof, and/or to waive any informality or informalities in any bid or the bidding process. The Town of Prospect will base its evaluation of the bids on price, the demonstrated skill, ability and integrity of each bidder to perform the work required in the bid package documents and any other factor or criterion that the Town of Prospect deems relevant or pertinent for such evaluation. Neither the Town of Prospect nor any of its officers, employees or authorized agents shall be liable for any claims or damages resulting from the evaluation, selection, non-selection or rejection of any bid submitted in response hereto. All bids shall remain open for Sixty (60) days after the bid due date.

Bidding documents will also be made available at Advanced Reprographics upon a non-refundable payment to be advised at the time of order/pick-up for EACH SET. Make check payable to Advanced Reprographics. Addenda will be issued to all Bidders who have secured Drawings and Specifications from Advanced Reprographics. Faxes or emails of Addenda will not be provided by the Engineer or Town.

The contractor who is selected to perform this State project must comply with CONN. GEN. STAT. §§ 4a-60, 4a-60g, and 46a-68b through 46a-68f.

This contract is subject to state contract compliance requirements, including nondiscrimination statutes and spending allocation goals. There is \$500,000 in state-funding for this project. State law requires project-specific goals be set for this project based on the project's needs and available Small Business Enterprises ("SBEs") and Minority Business Enterprises ("MBEs"). The SBE goal for this project is 29.39%. The MBE goal for this project is 15.51%. The selected contractor must demonstrate good faith effort to meet the spending allocation goals.
