

ORDINANCE 2019-03

AN ORDINANCE CONVERTING AN ELECTED OFFICE OF TOWN TREASURER TO A TOWN BOARD
APPOINTED OFFICE OF TOWN TREASURER

TOWN OF RANTOUL, CALUMET COUNTY, WISCONSIN

THE TOWN BOARD of the Town of Rantoul, Calumet County, Wisconsin does hereby ordain as follows:

That, pursuant to Wis. Stats 60.30(1e)(a), the office of the Town Treasurer shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the Town Board.

The term of office for the appointed position shall be set by the Town Board, but may not exceed 3 years per 60.30(1e)(c). The Town Board may re-appoint the officer for additional terms. However, removal by the Town Board during a given term of office may only be for "cause" as defined under 17.001 and required by 60.30(1e)(f).

This ordinance is subject to approval by the town electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the Town Board to be held on April 7, 2019. The referendum question shall be:

"Shall the person holding the office of Town Treasurer in the Town of Rantoul be appointed by the Town Board?"

The salary of the appointed position shall be set by the Town Board and may not be reduced during the term of office.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its Town Board passage, notice after passage per 60.80 and also its referendum approval by the town electors as required by 60.30(1e)(b).
