NEW BUSINESS

a. Review of employee salaries for fiscal 2007/08.

Discussion of the Board as to the current CPI (consumer price index) reports, estimate of employee benefits and present salaries. Consensus was to give the permanent employees: Mark Davis, Janina Patrus and Terry Dillon a 3% cost of living increase this year. Probationary employee Missy Clarke will receive the committed \$1,500 at her six month level. **Item was added as'd' under New Business in tonight's Regular Meeting.**

b. Discussion of the proposal for web services.

No one from the Tech Committee was available to answer questions. Suggestion was made that with proper web site, in emergency situations, Town residents could be informed, 'in live time' of town conditions. Item was deferred to the August 21 meeting.

c. Short term rentals

Presently Town does not have an enforceable ordinance on the books. Previous Attorney wrote an interpretation letter referencing zoning appendix A, definition of the State Statute. Board recommends that Attorney Burbine look into preparing an enforceable ordinance to cover the short-term rental issues. Discussion of Board to receive a fee schedule for this preparation.

No further business, Mayor called a short recess. **Workshop adjourned at 8 p.m.**
