NEW BUSINESS

Review of the proposed 2007-2008 Budget. Mayor Simons asked Deputy Clerk Missy Clarke to participate in the discussion and the changes made in the Budget worksheet. Additional amendments were discussed.

- a. Accts. 313.200 and 313.900 Revenue, were modified.
- b. Dept. 524, Protective Services amounts were changed by Commissioner Peck-Epstein.
- c. Acct. 572.524 Park Board, adjusted by an additional \$1,000 for shell and mulch.
- d. Acct. 572.522 Gasoline & Oil was reduced.
- e. Dept. 600 Replacement Reserve account amounts were adjusted.
- f. Dept. 700 Capital Outlay was re adjusted.
- g. Transfer amounts will be put into Roads and Streets and Storm Drain Replacement.

In summation, Mayor Simons thanked the Finance Committee, Park Board and the Commissioners for their time and efforts in producing the budget. First Public Hearing will be Thursday September 6 at 7 p.m. Clerk will prepare a summary budget for Public review. Deputy Clerk will update the budget.
