Having been duly advertised as required by law, the **Public Budget Hearing** of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Redington Beach, Florida, was held on **Thursday September 23, 2010 at 7:00 PM**, in the Redington Beach Town Hall at 105 – 164TH Avenue, Redington Beach.

Resolution 2010-15

**A Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Redington Beach, Pinellas County, Florida
Adopting the Final Levy of Ad Valorem Taxes for Pinellas County for Fiscal Year 2010-2011;
and Providing for an Effective Date**

Attorney Sirico read the Resolution by title. Mayor Simons summarized the budget process. Based on recommendations from the Finance Committee the Board adopted the tentative millage of 1.9410 in July; the Finance Committee worked with the Town staff in preparing the budget and work shopped it in August and September; the first public budget hearing was held September 9th. Fiscal year 2010-2011 operating millage rate for the Town of Redington Beach will remain at 1.9410 mills per \$1,000 which is less than the rolled-back rate of 2.1139 mills by (8.18)%. There being no Public comments or Board discussion, **Motion** made by Commissioner Deighton and seconded by Commissioner Dorgan to adopt Resolution 2010-15 setting the final levy of the Ad Valorem taxes. **Roll Call Vote:**

Attorney Sirico read the resolution by title. Commissioner Deighton explained the budget summary. The total budget of \$2, 405,833 is comprised of the general revenue of \$1,083,683 plus the capital reserves of \$1,229,650; this is in preparation for the Town roads and street project in 2011.
