OLD BUSINESS

a. Ordinance 10-13

An Ordinance of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Redington Beach, Florida Amending Chapter 16, Article III, Section 16-57, Permit for Peddling or Soliciting Door to Door; and Providing for an Effective Date. [Ord. 10-13 was first read on Dec. 7, and published Dec. 26, 2010; following discussion it was tabled Jan. 4, 2011 for a workshop.] Board received for review and discussion: Ord. 10-13 the second draft, Town original code, copy of N. Redington Beach solicitation code, and attorney's legal opinion letter. Upon Board discussion, it was deemed that Attorney would write a new ordinance, Ord. 11-02 revising present Town code Sec. 16-56 and Sec. 16-57, include solicitation definition and exceptions. Ord. 11-02 will be brought to Board Feb. 15 Board meeting for its first reading. Consensus of the Board was to move Ord. 10-13 to Regular Meeting agenda under (b) Old Business, for vote to permanently table.

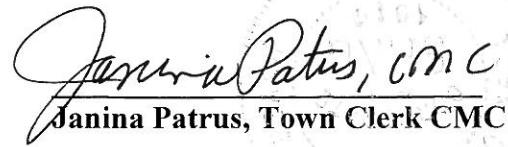
b. Redington Drive, traffic between 156th and 157th Avenues.

Residents complaint of speeding on sections of 1st St. & Redington Drive from 155th Ave. through 157th Ave. prompted, Board discussion on location of present Stop signs and comments on feasibility and need for additional stop signs. Public comment was heard from David

Drillick, 1st. Street. Consensus of the Board was to move item to Regular Meeting agenda under (a) New Business .
