OLD BUSINESS

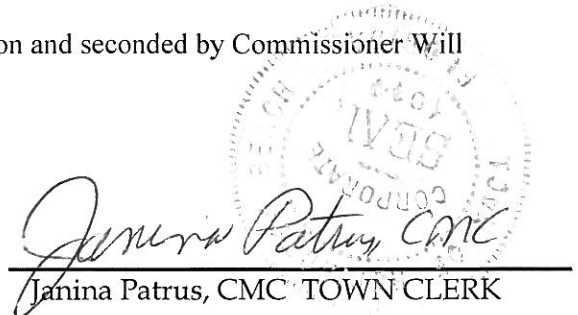
- a. **Gulf Blvd. Pedestrian Crossing Discussion** - Mayor Simons said Town issued invitation to FDOT and their consultants to attend this meeting; the reply was no one would be attending. FDOT was in the process of making amendments to the road plans and when they were completed the towns would be notified. Mayor opened for Public comments. Marilyn Barber, Redington Drive – said the FDOT could possibly consider adding a bike lane to Gulf Blvd. Anna Wiggers 2nd Street - said that pedestrian crossing lights should be RED instead of Yellow, forcing drivers to stop. Attorney said that FDOT follows State and Federal road standards and will not change the lights to flashing Red; this is not a traffic control device, just a cautionary light. Board discussion ensued. Town has made its position known on the proposed Gulf Blvd. medians in letter sent to FDOT in January; this letter will be submitted as further reference to Town's concern for the safety of our residents.
