Motion by Commissioner Will and seconded by Commissioner Dorgan to approve the Agenda. **Agenda approved with all ayes.**

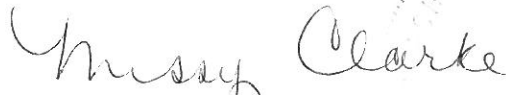

NEW BUSINESS

Discussion on proposed building of public restroom facility at beach park. Mayor Simons requested that the commissioners speak of the Pro's and Con's of a public restroom as well as public input. Mr. Jim Wigger's volunteered to write these down as they were said. A copy of which is attached to the minutes. Discussion ensued as to the location of the proposed restroom and Commissioner Will indicated that it would be located near the town's bulletin board and bike rack.
