Motion by Vice Mayor Deighton and seconded by Commissioner Will to approve the Agenda.

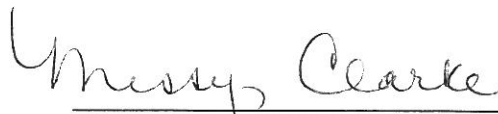
Agenda approved with all ayes.

NEW BUSINESS

- a. **Special Magistrate:** Mayor Simons briefed the board members on the meeting he had with Mark Davis and attorney's Daigneault and Huffman. Attorney Huffman stated that the town's ordinance allows for the town to use a special magistrate, a code enforcement board or the court system. Attorney Huffman also explained that the court system does not accrue fines daily, where a magistrate can impose daily fines. Mark Davis, Code Enforcement officer would have the discretion as to which case should go to the circuit court and which should go in front of the magistrate. The board of commissioners would need to appoint a special magistrate if they decide to go with a magistrate. The consensus of the board was to proceed with appointing a magistrate and to put this item on the agenda for the first meeting in June.
- b. **Board of Adjustment Ordinance Review:** At the January meeting, the board had discussed having the board of adjustment ordinances reviewed by the attorney. Attorney Huffman presented a draft to the commission. He noted that the interpretation of the appellate process was not clear. The consensus of the board was to pursue amending the ordinance for clarity. The first reading will be at the June 4th meeting.
