Attorney Huffman read the resolution by title. Vice Mayor Deighton explained the budget summary. The total budget of \$1,412,384.00 is comprised of the general revenue of \$1,023,042.00, plus capital revenues of \$221,592.00, and stormwater revenue of \$167,600.00. 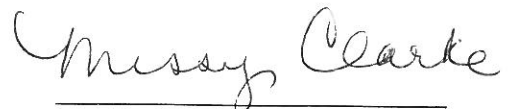
