OLD BUSINESS

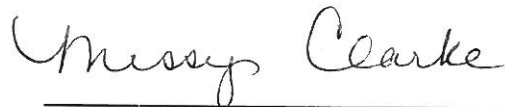
- A. **Lighting Ordinance:** Attorney Metz drew up the ordinance as there had been complaints regarding lighting. The commission made revisions to the ordinance and Attorney Metz will make revisions. One question brought up was how to enforce. The ordinance calls for a portable light meter. The clerk will check with the Pinellas County Sheriff's office to see if this is something they have available.
- B. **Beach Park Hours:** Beach Park did not have defined times for parking, whereas the other two parks had designated times. The commission made minor changes to the ordinance which Attorney Metz will make prior to the first reading.
- C. **Fireworks Ordinance:** The town did not have a fireworks ordinance prior. No changes to draft. The town staff will need to create a form for a fireworks permit.
- D. **Ordinance/Personnel:** In some sections in the town's ordinances, it referred to the "Director of Public Works". Since the town no longer has a director, new designations would need to be made. The commission went through the ordinance and made designations for each blank. Attorney Metz will make changes prior to the first reading.
