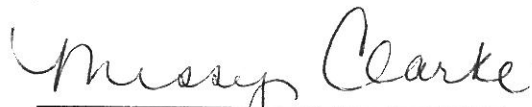
OLD BUSINESS

- A. **Rainwater Run-off:** Bob Welch of Florida Municipal Services reviewed some of the ordinances from neighboring towns. The goal is to not flood out neighboring properties. Several things can be done if the storm water conveyance system can handle the extra rain water. The consensus of the commission was to keep the ordinance simple, but be able to accomplish the goals. Bob Welch will work with Attorney Metz on drafting an ordinance for a future meeting.
- B. **Budget 2015-2016:** Commissioner Deighton noted that the finance committee met and reviewed the first six months of the fiscal year. The revenues are on target, except for the few that are on a three month cycle. The majority of the expenses are on target, except for legal fees, these are over budget. He noted that the town truck and tractor are fully funded in the reserve accounts and that this should be a budget item for next fiscal year. He also noted that the finance committee discussed giving the Park Board more monies to accomplish their goals at town park and the two vacant lots. Also discussed was purchasing lawn equipment for public works to mow the parks and cul de sacs. A suggestion was to re-negotiate the lawn service contract and go through one summer with the two public works employees and see the time availability of public works

With no further business, motion made by Commissioner Deighton and seconded by Commissioner Steiermann to adjourn. Regular session was adjourned at 8:14 p.m.
