REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
March 2, 2020**

The Park Board of the Town of Redington Beach, Florida met on Monday, March 2, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. in Redington Beach Town Hall, at 105-164th Avenue, Redington Beach, Florida.

CALL TO ORDER and PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

APPROVAL OF MINUTES of February 3, 2020

Jackie Tamburri motioned to approve; Shawntay Skjoldjager seconded.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA of March 2, 2020

Shawntay Skjoldiager motion to approve with changes, Jackie Tamburri seconded.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Work Order Status
 - a. Town Park Shelter beam painting is still in progress.
 - b. Town Park Tighten/adjust chimes / need is still being monitored.
 - c. Town Park Adding sand to 5-12 playground area still deferred until after installation of new equipment.

2. New Playground Equipment

Removal of current equipment will be done by Public Works with the hopes of reusing the items. Equipment will be temporarily stored on town property. The old cement bases will be removed by an outside contractor for a fee of \$550. Game Time will be providing a new quote reflecting these changes.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Resident Request: 158th - 159th triangle improper usage and unsightly condition. Resident Wally Hawthorne brought to the Board's attention damage being done to the triangle area with the increase of unregulated parking and foot traffic by what seems to be non-residents. Photos and an email from Ronald Graham, a Town resident, were presented by Park Board Member Rich Cariello. Mr. Cariello also mentioned his report given on April 17, 2019 during the Commission meeting addressing these issues. As a temporary measure, Commissioner Fred Steiermann instructed Town Clerk Missy Clarke to have "No parking on grass" signs posted along the triangle area. Commissioner Steiermann will be speaking to engineer Lynn Burnett to determine if this area is part of her flood plan study. Kris Johanson requested Town Clerk Missy Clarke obtain material cost for posts and rope to form a perimeter fence.
2. Resident Request for the Town to provide a "Pickle Ball Court". Due to the lack of needed unused open area within the Town the request was declined.
