**UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

**1. WORK ORDER STATUS**

- A. TOWN PARK Public Works continues to monitor and tighten chimes as needed.
- B. TOWN PARK Re-sanding of the 5-12 playground area on hold made part other work.
- C. 158th St Triangle Installed pilings and rope. In progress. No additional complaints.
- D. TOWN PARK handicap gate entrance has been reinstalled by Public Works. Completed.
- E. BEACH PARK bench COVID-19 spacing completed but location of benches keeps getting moved by the public. The spacing will be monitored by Public Works and corrected as needed. Completed.
- F. 4th St Cul De Sac trimming has been done awaiting town inspection. Completed.
- G. Bob Kahn grass edging entry corrected to Friendship Park. Completed.

No additional work order requests at this time.

**2. PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT REFUNDING** - Request replenishment of \$20,000 to be made part of the 2021 budget. Town Clerk Missy Clarke will request this to be approved.

### **3. AUSTRALIAN PINES REMOVAL**

Prime Scape will start removing the Australian Pines and prepare the area for new planting on September 8th. Job should be complete in a couple of days.

### **4. REPLACEMENT PLANTINGS**

Eugenia Stoppers were decided as the replacement trees. Town Clerk Missy Clarke will ask the company who will be doing the job for their recommendation on number of trees needed and if the plants we selected will do well. Project cost will be sent to the Park Board for review when available.

**5. SAIL SHADES** for playground area should be available within the next couple of weeks.

### **6. FRIENDSHIP PARK PERGOLA**

Kris Johanson reported that the new cement area was vandalized with a "male anatomy" drawing and a "racial slur". PCSO was notified and an official report was filed on August 20th. The contractor will repair the area. Additional evening patrols by the Sheriff's Department have been requested. Mention was made of an increase in local area crime. Cars being stolen and home break-ins.

The photo of the 16x20 pergola revealed 8 posts which would restrict the viewing area. Commissioner Will suggested the Park Board visit the park to determine the best pergola size. After polling the board Kris Johanson determined this meeting will be moved to the park after the completion of today's businesses.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

2020 budget money of \$5800 to be used to pay for Eugenia Stoppers Trees replacing the Australian Pines. Any remaining money will be used for plants in Friendship Park.

Normal Yearly Funding of \$20,000.

New Lighting for Town Park. May require additional funding. Town Clerk Missy Clarke will contact vendors for cost and send information to Park Board.
